## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Tournament will be held under the ITTF Rules and Regulations unless otherwise varied by supplementary Rules & Regulations implemented by TTA and / or TTSA.
2. All events will be the best of five (5) games to 11 points unless otherwise stipulated.
3. Initial rounds of singles events will be conducted as round robins. Doubles will be played on a knock-out basis.
4. The D40+ DHS 3-Star Plastic White Ball will be used for all events.
5. All Players are required to assist with umpiring.
6. All competitors must be registered members of a Club or Association affiliated with a State Association affiliated with TTA (other than if entering Events 15 & 20 ONLY).
7. Dress regulations of the ITTF will be enforced. No clothing of predominantly the same colour as the nominated ball may be worn. Any question of legality or acceptability of dress shall be decided by the Referee. No tracksuits or part thereof may be worn while playing except with the permission of the referee.
8. Each match shall be controlled by an Umpire, whose decision shall be final in point of fact. The Referee's decision shall be final on any interpretation of the rules.
9. Any player not ready to play when called may be disqualified.
10. Completed score cards must be initialled and returned promptly by the winning player after each match.
11. A 2 minute warm-up period will be allowed and play must commence promptly after this time.
12. No gluing of rackets is permitted in the playing area. Only approved glue or glue sheets may be used.
13. Ratings Central Singles – players may only enter a maximum of two (consecutive) of the 5 RC events being offered. The player rating used will be that shown on Ratings Central as at 5pm on the closing date, Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2019. Note: < means 'less than'.
14. This tournament is conducted pursuant to TTSA Policies and Regulations. It is a condition of entry that all players agree to abide by these policies and regulations and are liable for any breaches.
15. ELIGIBILITY. Age as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018.
16. Event 15 is open to U/13 Smash Hit and school competition players, excluding past and present State Junior U/13 representatives.
17. The Tournament Committee / Director shall have the sole management of the tournament and its decision will be final, including the right to:
  - 1) Cancel any event due to insufficient entries
  - 2) Refuse an entry
  - 3) Alter times of play if necessary
  - 4) Add late entries where players have withdrawn due to illness or injury in accordance with I.T.T.F regulations.
18. The TTSA Hot Weather Policy will apply (refer policy on TTSA web site). Note – Southern Table Tennis venue is an air-conditioned environment.
19. Where no substantiated justification exists, players who fail to pay their entry fees will be subject to restriction from entering future SA tournaments.

### **PLAYERS PLEASE NOTE – *TTSA has elected to continue changes implemented in 2018...***

- the removal of mixed doubles & restricted singles from sanctioned junior tournaments,
- Ratings Central events have been included to enable players to compete against other players of a like standard, regardless of age. A player may enter a maximum of 2 consecutive RC events.

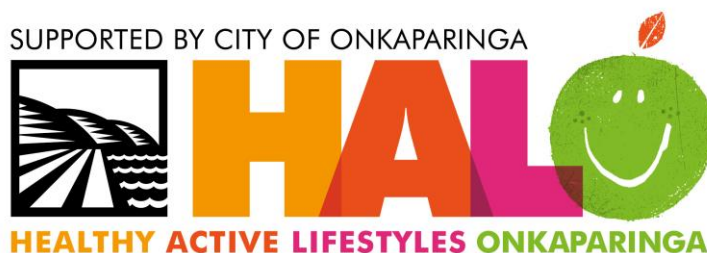
