## COVID-19 SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

1. Players and patrons are not to enter the stadium if unwell or having cold / flu like symptoms
2. On entry to the stadium, all persons who have a smart phone will register attendance using the QR Code App on their mobile phone. Junior players will report to the control desk to advise of their attendance. Those who cannot register by smartphone must report to the canteen and complete a manual record.
3. Only ONE adult (parent / relative / guardian) can accompany a junior player on the day. No spectators are allowed. This is to manage Covid-19 social distancing and density ratio requirements outlined in the stadium Safe Plan.
4. All persons must use hand hygiene on entering the stadium using the provided hand sanitiser at entry. Players and patrons are asked to undertake hand hygiene throughout the day and on departure from the stadium.
5. Players are required keep their towel and water bottle within their personal bag. The bag may be taken out on court and placed next to the umpire chair as required.
6. When umpiring and using the 'scorer / flipper', players will hand sanitise both before and after using this equipment. This requirement also applies to the use of umpire table clocks
7. Following the completion of a match, players will acknowledge their opponent and umpire but no shaking of hands shall occur.
8. Players will not touch their opponent's bat, but still have the right to inspect the nature of table tennis rubbers being used by their opponent.
9. Players will not wipe the playing table with their personal towel or wipe their hand on the table. Perspiration on the table will be managed by the umpire in a Covid-19 safe manner
10. Players must maintain social distancing during authorised intervals
11. Players are to only arrive at the stadium 30 minutes prior to their first scheduled event. On completion of all matches for the day, players should leave the venue as soon as possible.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Tournament will be held under the ITTF Rules and Regulations unless otherwise varied by supplementary Rules & Regulations implemented by TTA and / or TTSA.
2. All matches in this tournament will be 'timed', meaning that both the time and table number will be allocated to all individual matches being played during the day.
3. All events will be the best of five (5) games to 11 points unless otherwise stipulated.
4. Initial rounds of singles events will be conducted as round robins.
5. The D40+ DHS 3-Star Plastic White Ball will be used for all events.
6. All Players are required to assist with umpiring.
7. All competitors must be registered members of a Club or Association affiliated with a State Association affiliated with TTA.
8. Dress regulations of the ITTF will be enforced. No clothing of predominantly the same colour as the nominated ball may be worn. Any question of legality or acceptability of dress shall be decided by the Referee. No tracksuits or part thereof may be worn while playing except with the permission of the referee.
9. Each match shall be controlled by an Umpire, whose decision shall be final in point of fact. The Referee's decision shall be final on any interpretation of the rules.
10. Any player not ready to play when called may be disqualified.
11. Completed score cards must be initialled and returned promptly by the winning player after each match.
12. A two (2) minute warm-up period will be allowed and play must commence promptly after this time.
13. No gluing of rackets is permitted in the playing area. Only approved glue or glue sheets may be used.
14. This tournament is conducted pursuant to TTSA Policies and Regulations. It is a condition of entry that all players agree to abide by these policies and regulations and are liable for any breaches.
15. **ELIGIBILITY.** Age as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020.
16. The Tournament Committee / Director shall have the sole management of the tournament and its decision will be final, including the right to:
  - 1) Cancel any event due to insufficient entries
  - 2) Refuse an entry
  - 3) Alter times of play if necessary
  - 4) Add late entries where players have withdrawn due to illness or injury in accordance with I.T.T.F regulations.
17. The TTSA Hot Weather Policy will apply (refer policy on TTSA web site). Note – Southern Table Tennis venue is an air-conditioned environment.
18. Where no substantiated justification exists, players who fail to pay their entry fees will be subject to restriction from entering future SA tournaments.

Reminder – do not arrive at the stadium any earlier than 30 minutes prior to your first event

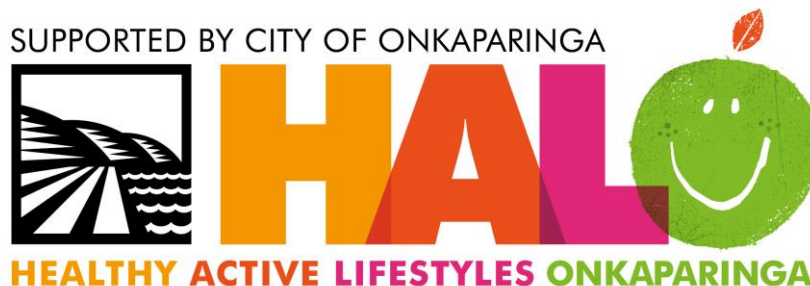
