TOURNAMENT - SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

1. 40+mm 3-Star DHS Seamed Plastic White balls will be used in all events.
2. Players that are 15 minutes or more late for their session scheduled start time will be forfeited.
3. NO WHITE CLOTHING to be worn.
4. Age groups are determined by your age on the 31st December during the current year.
5. Players may only play in two adjoining (touching) age groups where applicable e.g. O30/O40, O40/O50, O50/O60, O60/O65, O65/O70, O70/ O75 or O75/O80.
6. Singles events shall be RR – KO in groups of 3 or 4 where applicable. The winner of a round robin group will progress to the knockout stage. All matches are best of 5 games to 11 points.

COVID-19 – SPECIFIC CONDITIONS (Subject To STT Covid Safe Plan Changes)

1. Players and patrons are not to enter the stadium if unwell or having cold / flu like symptoms
2. On entry to the stadium, all persons who have a smart phone will register attendance using the QR Code. Those who cannot register by smartphone must complete the manual attendance register at the stadium entrance.
3. Masks must be worn when entering the stadium and when players are not on court or eating / drinking. Those with mask exemption must provide tournament control with a copy of their exemption.
4. All persons must use hand hygiene on entering the stadium using the provided hand sanitiser. Players and patrons are asked to undertake hand hygiene throughout the day and on departure from the stadium.
5. Players are required keep their towel and water bottle within their personal bag. The bag may be taken out on court and placed next to the umpire chair as required.
6. Following the completion of a match, players will acknowledge their opponent and umpire but no shaking of hands shall occur.
7. Players will not touch their opponent's bat, but still have the right to inspect the nature of table tennis rubbers being used by their opponent.
8. Players will not wipe the playing table with their personal towel or wipe their hand on the table. Perspiration on the table will be managed by the umpire in a Covid-19 safe manner
9. Players are to only arrive at the stadium 30 minutes prior to their first scheduled event. On completion of all matches for the day, players should leave the venue as soon as possible.
